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The Inspection

Inspection design

On 15 November 2019, based on article 1.62, fifth section of the Wet Kinderopvang, and following up to an enforcement procedure initiated by the Municipality, an additional investigation was performed. The investigation consists of a documentation research and a telephonic conversation with the team leader.

An additional investigation does not provide the holder with the opportunity to submit a point of view.

Reflection

Organisation

Hestia Rivierenbuurt B.V. is part of Hestia Holding B.V.. The person bearing final responsibility for the policy to be implemented is the director; additionally she is the manager and only shareholder of Hestia Holding B.V. which consists of three B.V.'s with a total of five children's centres in Amsterdam-Zuid and Amstelveen. The locations are headed by team leaders who each manage one or two children's centres (at one address).

Location

Children's day care Hestia Rivierenbuurt B.V., together with the after school care with the same name, is established in a building in the neighbourhood called 'Rivierenbuurt'. The children's day care consists of three horizontal core groups (Yellow, Green and Blue). Every core group has its own group space, however additionally communal spaces are being used avidly by all; for example, the hot meal is enjoyed in one of the piazza's on a daily basis.

Enforcement

The inspection report of the yearly inspection, dated 22 November 2018, contained multiple observed violations, including a violation with regards to ensuring that at least one adult qualified for administering first aid to children is present at all times during the day.

In response to these violations, the Municipality of Amsterdam has issued an instruction on 15 May 2019. During the additional investigation dated 23 July 2019 it was concluded that the holder has again committed the violation, after which the Municipality of Amsterdam issued an order subject to incremental penalty. In the current investigation it has been determined whether the holder has complied with this order.

Advice to Municipality

With regards to the deployment of first aid-educated staff, the supervisor has not observed any violations. The supervisor advises to accept this report for informative purposes.

Observations and Findings

Safety and Health

Safety and Health policy

During the previous additional investigation, dated 23 July 2019, three staff members were qualified for administering first aid to children according to the additional rules connected to this qualification, set in the Regeling Wet Kinderopvang. A fourth employee was in the possession of a certificate that expired per 1 July 2019. During the researched time period from 2 June 2019 up until and including 23 July 2019, as well as the yearly inspection dated 22 November 2018, it transpired that they failed in ensuring a first-aid qualified staff member had been present in the children's centre at all times during the day.

In the current additional investigation, it has been demonstrated by three preschool teachers and the team leader that they are qualified for administering first aid to children by putting forward their certificates. One of them is on leave during week 45 and 46. A second first aid-qualified employee has ceased being employed at Hestia per 13 November 2019. The team leader has stated via an email dated 18 November 2019 that additionally, four English-speaking employees working at the day care centre have taken a first aid course on 9 November 2019. This course is offered by *EHBO Bureau*, a certified partner of the Red Cross. The certificates awarded to these employees have not yet been received by the holder, but during a telephone call on 20 November 2019 the holder declares that it is confirmed that all English-speaking staff members have passed the training. The holder further explains that by implementing yearly schooling in the field of first aid, it shall be ensured that all the permanent staff is in the possession of valid first aid certificates. Additionally, they are in conversations with the employment agency to explore whether the agency workers can also take first aid lessons, in order for them to also be qualified to administer first aid to children.

The supervisor has assessed the deployment of first aid-qualified staff in the time period 28 October up until and including 15 November 2019. Based on the staff schedules in the investigated time period, it is shown that a first aid-qualified adult was present in the children's centre at all times during the day.

The violation has not been repeated.
