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## Observations and Findings

### Staff and groups

Number of professionals and requirements with regards to the deployment of professionals in training and interns

During the annual inspections of 2018 and 2019, and the additional investigation on September 1, 2020, violations were observed regarding the teacher-child ratio.

#### *Current inspection*

On 10 June 2021, the day of this inspection visit, enough teachers are working at the daycare center:

- In the Yellow group, 9 children are cared for by 3 teachers;
- In the Green group, 12 children are cared for by 2 teachers;
- In the Blue group, 13 children are cared for by 2 teachers;
- In the Terra group (half-day care), 10 children are cared for by 2 teachers.

This number of teachers matches the number of children being cared for and their age.

A random check was made of the attendance lists and schedules in the period from 25 May to 10 June 2021. This check shows that during this period too, enough teachers were deployed for the number of children who were cared for.

Whether the teacher-child ratio is deviated from for a maximum of 3 hours per day and whether this is done according to the times as described in the pedagogical policy plan, was not assessed in this inspection. This will be examined in the 2021 annual inspection.

#### *Conclusion*

During this inspection, it has been assessed that the condition as described in the order subject to a penalty is met. The schedule clearly shows which teacher worked in which group on which day: in contrast to the schedule received during the additional investigation on 1 September 2020 there are no teachers scheduled for multiple groups at the same time. However, the administration remains a point of attention. For example, the timetable shows that 1 teacher in the Green group worked until 17.15hr on the day of the inspection visit, while she had already stopped working around 16.30hr. The teachers of this group also state that 13 children were present, while the attendance list shows that there were 12. The situation has been discussed with the location manager and he says that if teachers go home earlier, this is communicated, after which the schedule are changed accordingly. This did not happen on the day of the inspection visit. He also says that the working hours on the schedule on the other days are the same as in practice. During the next inspection, extra attention will be paid to the administration and whether it is the same as in practice.

#### *Stability of care for children*

During the annual inspection in 2020, it was assessed that care does not take place in core groups. This inspection showed a child to have been cared for in 3 core groups, while a child may only be cared for in 1 other core group.

#### *Current inspection*

There are 4 core groups at the daycare:

- Yellow group, for children aged 0-3 years, where a maximum of 12 children are cared for with 3 pedagogical employees;
- Green group, for children aged 0-4 years, where a maximum of 16 children, depending on the age structure, are cared for with 3 or 4 pedagogical employees;
- Blue group, for children aged 2-5 years where a maximum of 15 children are cared for with 2 pedagogical employees;

- Terra, half-day care, for children aged 1.5-4 years, where a maximum of 16 children are cared for with 3 pedagogical employees.

On the day of the inspection visit, all children eat together in the piazza. All groups sit at their own table, according to the 'bubble' policy drawn up in connection with the corona measures.

Children are placed in 1 or 2 core groups. 2 children have been placed in 2 main groups (full-day care and half-day care): this is included in the placement contract. Sometimes children can also be cared for in 1 other core group during an exchange day or extra day. Written permission for this is requested from the parent(s) in advance. This happened once in the examined period from 25 May to 10 June 2021.

### *Conclusion*

During this inspection it was assessed that care took place in core groups.

## Inspection Items

### Staff and groups

Number of professionals and requirements with regards to the deployment of professionals in training and interns

- The holder of a children's centre employs sufficient professionals for the amount of the children that are cared for, provided that:
  - The ratio between the minimum number of teachers to be deployed and the amount of present children in the core group is determined based on table 1 in annex 1, component a of the Besluit kwaliteit kinderopvang and the accompanying counting rules;
  - If a core group is combined with a base group, the ratio between the minimum number of teachers to be deployed and the number of children present in the combined group is determined on the basis of Appendix 1, part c, to the Childcare Quality Act and the associated calculation rules;
  - In the case children leave a core group for an activity as described in the pedagogical policy plan, this does not lead to a decrease of the total amount of minimum professionals to be deployed on the group or, should the activity take place outside of the children's centre, with regards to the situation directly preceding the activity;
  - In deviation hereof less teachers can be deployed during times mentioned in the pedagogical policy plan, with a maximum of three hours;
  - During the daycare, a maximum of one third of the total minimum number of teachers to be deployed at the childcare center consists of teachers in training or trainees. The minimum number of teachers to be deployed at the childcare center is formed by the sum of the minimum number of professionals to be deployed in the separate parent groups pursuant to Article 7 of the Childcare Quality Act.

### Stability of care for children

- Daycare takes place in core groups. A child is assigned to one core group. The maximum group size is determined based on table 1 in annex 1, component a of the Besluit kwaliteit kinderopvang. In case a core group is combined with a base group, the maximum size of the core group is determined based on annex 1, element c of the Besluit kwaliteit kinderopvang.
